Likewise, click on the "Current Calendar" button to download a PDF of the current activity calendar. You can choose to print, display or save either of these documents. There's one difference between the paper version and the online version, the newsletter has been split from the activity calendar online. This is so you can read any of the past issues of the newsletter, whereas only the current activity calendar is available online.
